

## **AUTUMN ON THE SNAKE RIVER FLY FISHING PACKAGE**

The "Fish-and-Spa" option gives you long, exhilarating days on the river while your spouse or friend is happily pampered with Body Sage's unique spa treatments and Jackson's walking-distance shopping and culture, while the "Fishing Buddies" option allows you to share the wild river action with your spouse or friend. And of course both options include the high level of service, comfort and fine dining experience Rusty Parrot guests expect.

### **The Fish-and-Spa three-night option includes:**

- Three nights accommodations in a first floor king or double queen room
- Full chef-prepared breakfast each morning of your stay
- One dinner for two in the Four Diamond Wild Sage restaurant
- Two days of fly fishing for one person on the South Fork of the Snake River, with an overnight at the South Fork camp, including 2 lunches, 1 dinner, and 1 breakfast, and specified equipment.

**The Snake River**

The Snake River is a fantastic fishery for anglers of all ability levels. The fishery is very healthy, with strong numbers of native Snake River Finespot Cutthroat Trout. The average size fish is 8" - 14", with many fish over 16" and a surprising amount in the 20"+ range. The beginning angler will have plenty of opportunities to hook and land trout in all size ranges, while getting the big 'yellow bellies' to pose for a picture takes some skill.

There are 80 miles of fishable river between Jackson Lake Dam and the end of the canyon at Palisades Reservoir. The upper stretch flows approx 35 miles through Grand Teton National Park and offers some of the most majestic scenery imaginable. The lower river has many different characteristics and produces some of the most consistent fishing.

**The South Fork of the Snake River**

The South Fork of the Snake River is where the Snake River flows out of Palisades Reservoir, better known as the South Fork. This is a very diverse river. From sight fishing to good fish in the shallow riffles with small PMD's and caddis to twitching big hoppers and stoneflies along the banks, the South Fork offers all types of fishing.

The valley stretches offer a broad river with many side channels and braids that provide great fishing in the riffles. The canyon stretch is 26 miles of wilderness. Cutthroat, rainbows and browns call this river home and can grow quite large. The fall fishing on the South Fork can provide some of the best action in the region.
